BOARD BILL 3.04: An Act to Allocate Funding for the October 2019 WSA General Assembly

WHEREAS: The Washington Student Association (WSA) exists to represent its member associations' shared legislative interests to the Washington State Legislature;

WHEREAS: The Associated Students of the University of Washington (ASUW) is a member association of the WSA;

WHEREAS: The WSA General Assembly (GA) is charged with drafting and approving the WSA Legislative Agenda;

WHEREAS: The ASUW has a vested interest in contributing to the WSA's Legislative Agenda and aligning the WSA's legislative priorities with the ASUW's;

WHEREAS: The ASUW and Graduate & Professional Student Senate at the University of Washington jointly hold nine (9) votes in the WSA GA, which are apportioned by each member institution's number of full time equivalent students, and thus, by proportional representation, have the largest share of proprietorship over the WSA;

WHEREAS: The WSA GA will take place October 12-October 13, 2019;

WHEREAS: The ASUW recognizes the importance of the WSA to the students of the University of Washington;

WHEREAS: The ASUW has not yet allocated funding for the October 2019 WSA GA in its 2019-2020 budget; now

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS

THAT: Up to \$280.00 be appropriated from the Board Discretionary Fund for the purposes of meals and lodging for the Director of University Affairs, who shall serve as the ASUW President's proxy ,and lodging for the Director of Legislative Affairs at the WSA General Assembly meeting; and

THAT: Up to \$83.00 be transferred from the Office of Government Relations' Fleet Services budget line to the WSA budget line, to be used for the purposes of meals for the Director of Legislative Affairs at the WSA General Assembly meeting; and

THAT: this bill be forwarded to Rene Singleton, SAO Adviser.

End
