AN ACT TO: Revise the Director of Community Relations and Director of Programming positions in relation to Homecoming

WHEREAS: Historically the Director of Programming has planned Homecoming, and;

WHEREAS: The Director of Community Relations joined forces with the Director of Programming this year to make Homecoming a bigger event on campus, and;

WHEREAS: The Director of Community Relations and the Director of Programming created the Homecoming Planning Committee this year that had a representative from each community and worked to create a Homecoming culture on campus, and;

WHEREAS: The Director of Programming has skills focused on event planning and collaboration, and;

WHEREAS: The Director of Community Relations has skills focused on community building and outreach, and;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS

THAT: "Serve as chair of the Homecoming Planning Committee with emphasis in programming;" be added as Article I, Section 6, 5, m. of the job description of the Director of Programming in the bylaws, and;

THAT: "Serve as co-chair of the Homecoming Planning Committee with emphasis in community connection;" be added as Article I, Section 6, 5, r. of the job description of the Director of Community Relations in the bylaws, and;

THAT: The Homecoming Planning Committee be added as an ASUW Standing Committee as Article VII, Section 7, G in the ASUW Bylaws

G. Homecoming Planning Committee

1. Membership:

- a. There shall be nine voting members with one representative from each group:
 - i. Director of Community Relations, who shall serve as co-chair;
 - ii. Director of Programming, who shall serve as co-chair;
 - iii. United Greek Council;
 - iv. National Pan-Hellenic Council;
 - v. Residence Hall Student Association;
 - vi. Inter-Fraternity Council;
 - vii. Student Advisory Board for the Office of Minority Affairs;
 - viii. Commuter Representative from Senate;
- b. There shall be two non-voting members:
 - i. Sorority and Fraternity Life Advisor;
 - ii. SAO Advisor;

2. Function:

- a. Shall plan any events or activities for Homecoming
- b. Shall coordinate with the University of Washington Alumni Association
- c. Shall convene at least once during Spring Quarter to begin planning for the following school year
- d. Shall be allotted a budget

THAT: The Director of Policy and Procedure has appropriate authority to renumber the affected sections of the bylaws

THAT: Board Bill 1.05 be forwarded to the ASUW Vice President Jocelyn McCurtain and the ASUW Personnel Director Dabney Donigan.
